

DECIDUOUS SHRUB PRUNING GUIDE FOR EASTERN CANADA

IN EARLY SPRING, ANY DEAD BRANCHES SHOULD BE CUT OUT, NO MATTER WHEN THE SHRUB IS TO BE PRUNED.

CHECK FOR DEAD BY FEELING BRANCH FOR COLD OR SCRATCHING TO SEE IF GREEN BELOW (CAUTIOUSLY).

THE FOLLOWING KEY IS MEANT AS A GUIDELINE ONLY, AND SPECIAL CASES MAY APPLY. IN GENERAL LATE SEASON PRUNING IS NOT A GOOD IDEA, AS IT MAY STIMULATE GROWTH THAT WILL THEN NOT HAVE A CHANCE TO HARDEN OFF BEFORE WINTER.

PRUNING METHOD

- A PRUNE HARD IN EARLY SPRING
- B PRUNE ONLY AFTER FLOWERS HAVE FINISHED
- C USUALLY DOES NOT NEED PRUNING, USE CAUTION
- D SHAPE AS NEEDED, BUT NOT AFTER JULY 15
- E PRUNE HARD AFTER ALL RISK OF FROST FINISHED AND LEAVES STARTING TO SHOW
- G PRUNE LIGHTLY AFTER LEAVES START TO SHOW
- H THIN OUT WHOLE CANES WHEN PRUNING
- J FLOWERS ON 2ND YEARS GROWTH. PRUNE OUT ONLY CANES WITH OLD FLOWERS
